Responsibilities

- Participates in educational presentations (shows, demonstrations, classroom presentations, exhibits, etc)
- Supervises children of all ages
- Prepares for and cleans up supplies after programs
- Answers questions about presentations and the Exploreum
- Makes sure all equipment is in working order
- Always presents a high level of professionalism when carrying out assigned duties and responsibilities

- Ability to work as a part of a team
- Must have a willingness to learn new things
- Ability to interact well with children
- Have an interest in science and technology education
- Possess excellent customer service and interpersonal skills
