Responsibilities

- Participates in educational presentation (shows, demonstrations, classroom presentations, exhibits, etc)
- Prepares for programs and cleans up afterwards.
- Encourages Exploreum visitors to participate in programs and exhibits
- Explains exhibits to visitors
- Fulfills all the duties of the Volunteer Exhibit Assistant when not presenting
- Always presents a high level of professionalism when carrying out assigned duties and responsibilities

- Must have a willingness to learn new things
- Ability to interact well with diverse audiences of all ages
- Have an interest in science and technology education
